

VOICE OF WOMEN RADIO PROGRAMME

Dear supporters of the voice of women Programme,

I hope all is well.

Let me thank you for the continued support to this impactful Programme. Many people have continued to give testimonies of how the programme has impacted their lives and the families they live in.

This programme has impacted men, women and the youths since different categories of people of people are hosted to preach, educate and sensitive the masses. But most specifically, the programme has impacted women.

In January, Alice, Judith and Enid taught about christian conduct where they encouraged people to follow God's ways if they are to impact the lives of people in the communities where they live.

In February, being a month for reporting back to schools, Amos and Enid gave a package to students about better conduct in schools and being content with the little the parents give them. Being content involved not giving in their bodies for the things they don't have. Amos used Proverbs 17:1 as the reference. Some students (girls) testified that old men tried tempting to have sex with these girls but because of the continued radio teachings, these girls overcame.

In March, Judith and Edison shared about the causes of conflicts in our homes and how to resolve them. They mainly talked about ending domestic violence in homes and advocating for gender equality. In this, a woman testified how the condition in her family had intensified because of gender based violence. But because of this program of the "Voice of women", she was comforted.

In April, Danet and Phabith talked about the God of impossibilities. She gave a testimony on how she had lost hope after losing all her parents but because of trusting the God of impossibilities, she got a sponsor who has paid for her up to the University. She used Luke 1:34-

38 as the reference. Phabith shared her testimony of spending 23 years without producing but because of trusting the God of impossibilities, she gave birth to twins.

In May, a team from World Shine Ministries led by Mr. Byendegye had a series of teachings in preparation for their conference. And indeed, the conference was a success. Many people got born in again and others were delivered.

In June, Medius, Enid and Rev Abiah as widows shared about sticking to God using the story of Naomi and Ruth using Ruth 1 as the reference. Medius testified how she has been living positively with HIV/AIDS for the last 23 years but still trusting God. She therefore encouraged women especially those who lost their husbands of AIDs to live positively.

In July, Kellen and Judith preached about obedience using 2Tim 1:5 and Acts 16:1 as reference books. In this, they shared how Paul wrote about Timothy's sincere faith which first lived in his grandmother Lois and his mother Eunice. The preacher also talked about not being ashamed of the testimony about our Lord.

In August, Enid, Penina and Gloria held different sessions about counselling tackling different reasons why people should seek counseling emphasizing that a problem once shared is half solved.

In September, Monday Richard and Judith shared about not letting our hearts to be troubled. They used Matthew 6:25-34 saying that we shouldn't worry about what we shall eat, drink or wear for we should know that our heavenly Father knows all that we need.

In October, Amos, Gilbert and Emily (students from Kabale university chapel) shared about casting our burdens to Jesus. This message was in preparation for their university conference. In that conference, 50 students got born again and a student testified how she wanted to commit suicide after eating tuition but was saved by the message that she heard in the "Voice of women Programme".

In November, Judith, Monday and Amabel had a topic of parent/child relationship during holidays the holidays. They used Ephesians 6:1-4 which emphasizes that children should be brought up in the training and instruction of the Lord.

In December, Sacred, Enid shared about the joy of a home using Psalm 133 for it is good and pleasant for God's people to live together in unity. The message was combined with the messages to prepare listeners for Christmas.

Thank you very much our dear supporters for your consistence in raising funds for this program that has impacted generations. May God continue to use you to reach millions of people that listen to this program.
